PROFILO INJECTIONS

1.What is Profhilo?

Profhilo is a skin booster which is composed of a combination of low molecular weight and high molecular weight hyaluronic acid. Hyaluronic acid is a naturally occurring substance that maintains moisture within the skin.

2.What can Profhilo do?

Profhilo provides deep hydration and rejuvenates the skin. It also stimulates the production of collagen and elastin. Your skin will appear more hydrated, plump and radiant.

3.How is Profhilo injected?

On the face or neck, Profhilo is injected with a fine needle under the skin into 10 specific points (5 on each side). The injection sites on the face are: upper cheek, nasal base, lower cheek, jawline and chin.

4.How often should I have Profhilo?

You should have two treatments 4-6 weeks apart then every 6 months subsequently.

5.What are the possible side effects of Profhilo?

- Inflammatory reactions (redness and swelling, sometimes associated with itch and pain) may occur and last for 7-10 days. If these last longer than 7-10 days, please contact your healthcare provider
- Hardening or nodules may appear at the injection point
- Bruising
- Very rare
 - o Discolouration at the injection point
 - o Necrosis of the glabellar area
 - o Abscess
 - o Granuloma
 - o Hypersensitivity reaction
 - o Scarring
- Extremely rare: blindness or stroke
